REENACTMENT RULES

All participants are required to comply with all rules and guidelines. Any participant failing to comply will be subject to removal from the event. This is for your safety.

- A Participants shall provide all information requested on the registration form and sign the statement on compliance relating to guidelines, rules, and codes of conduct.
- ▲ Each person expecting to gain entry to the site must be registered and pay appropriate fee. Make unit designations clear. All registrants will be issued a Provost Pass that must be carried on their person at all times.
- ▲ In order for 12 and 13 year old to go on the field they must be functioning musicians or attached to medical. They must show that they are mature and responsible enough to handle the dangerous environment of a battlefield.
- ▲ Individual must be at least 14 years of age to carry a weapon on the field.
- All registrants need to be mindful of restrictions on vehicular access to camps. All vehicles must have parking pass and park in designated parking areas. Vehicles unloading must be out of camp by 0800 Saturday. Vehicles will be allowed to return to camps 30 minutes after Sunday's battle (3:30pm).
- A No Vehicles (including golf carts) or horses will be allowed on sutler row at any time.
- All uniforms and equipment must be of proper materials, construction, and appearance for impression being portrayed. For authenticity additional units may be asked to galvanize.
- ▲ Weapons recommended for Infantry will be three band muskets. Artillery and Cavalry are expected to have correct firearms for their impressions. No soldiers will be allowed on the field until attending safety inspection and showing Provost Pass.
- ▲ No live ammunition will be allowed on the property.
- ▲ The amount of powder used in a cartridge may not exceed 70 grains; Cartridges must be made with period construction materials. No penny wrappers, staples, wads, or wax may be used in cartridge construction.
- A Belt knives are discouraged and shall never be drawn on the battlefield. All belt knives must be tied down. Fake knives are not authorized at any time
- ▲ State Law requires that horses have a current Coggins Certificate. No horses in sutler row, please.
- ▲ For liability reasons No Pets are allowed.
- ▲ Military impressions are limited to Infantry, Navy, Artillery, Cavalry, and Medical.
- A No individual or small group charges against the enemy will be allowed during the spectator battle.
- A Hand to hand fighting will not be permitted unless it is approved and coordinated in advance.
- ▲ Illegal substances, drugs or visible intoxication will not be tolerated
- Alcohol should be consumed in moderation. "Sloppy drunkenness" will not be tolerated.
- ▲ Camp in designated areas only. If you camp outside of the specified areas you will be asked to move. No exceptions.
- A Fire pits allowed in designated camps only and must be filled in at the end of the event.
- △ Cooking fires only. No bon fires. Fires must be attended at all times.
- All modern equipment must remain hidden from sight at all times.
- △ Only approved venders will be allowed to sell food at the event.
- All trash must be removed at the end of the event. Please leave it in the dumpster (see map).
- △ Cavalry Please stay within the gate at the main entrance of the farm. **Do not ride outside of the gate**.
